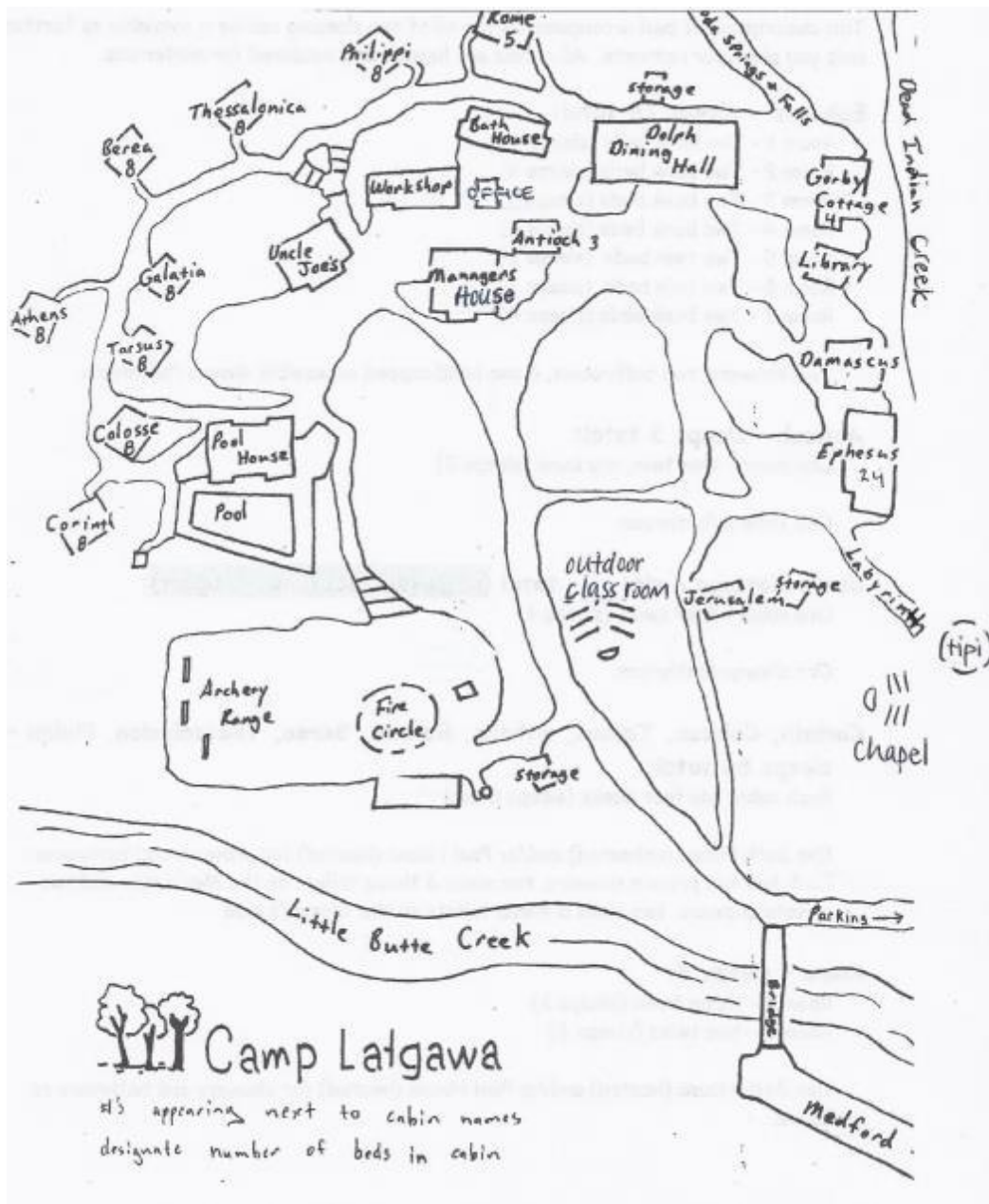

This description of bed arrangements for all of our sleeping cabins is available to further help you plan your retreats. All cabins are heated and insulated for winter use.

Ephesus - sleeps 24 total:

Room 1 – Two bunk beds (sleeps 4)

Room 2 – Two bunk beds (sleeps 4)

Room 3 – Two bunk beds (sleeps 4)

Room 4 – Two bunk beds (sleeps 4)

Room 5 – Two twin beds (sleeps 2)

Room 6 – Two twin beds (sleeps 2)

Room 7 – Two bunk beds (sleeps 4)

Two showers, two bathrooms, & one handicapped accessible shower/bathroom

Antioch – sleeps 3 total:

One room – One twin, one bunk (sleeps 3)

One shower/bathroom

Gorby Cottage – sleeps 4 total:

First Aid quarters in summer. Inquire about availability.

One room – Four twins (sleeps 4)

One shower/bathroom

Corinth, Colosse, Tarsus, Athens, Galatia, Berea, Thessalonica, Philippi – sleep 64 total:

Each cabin has four bunks (sleeps 8 each)

Use Bath House (heated) and/or Pool House (heated) for showers and bathroom – The men's side has two private showers, two sinks & three toilets. The women's side has two private showers, two sinks & three toilets.

Rome – sleeps 10:

Room 1 – three bunks (sleeps 6)

Room 2 – two bunks (sleeps 4)

Use Bath House (heated) and/or Pool House (heated) for showers and bathroom as above.

Damascus – in transition:

Flexible cabin for meetings, staff housing, etc. *Inquire about availability.*

One shower, one bathroom, and one sink in common area.
